## **Dvar Torah**

In this week's parasha, *Vayakhel-Pekudei, Betzalel* is chosen to lead the building of the *Mishkan* along with *Aholiav*. While there are many explanations as to why *Aholiav* was chosen, why was *Betzalel* chosen? What was so special about him? Rav Taragin suggests a possible explanation.

Even though *Betzalel's* name means in the shadow of God's presence/wisdom there is more to why he was chosen. The Torah specifies his ancestry- his father's name and his grandfather's name. *Betzalel ben Ori ben Chur*. Chazal tells us in a *midrash* that *Chur* played an important role in Beztalel's becoming the leader of the building of the Mishkan -- Chur

attempted to stop the Jewish people from building the golden calf. He was killed for doing this, and was rewarded with his grandson becoming the one to build the *Mishkan*.

Why are these two connected? The Mishkan was a project that aimed to build something more than physical that helped form a connection with God. The builder should be someone who descends from a line that believes in something more than physical and forming that connection with God. Even though it seems impossible for one person to stop an entire nation from sinning, and succeed, Chur tried. And even though he didn't succeed, he was rewarded when his grandson was chosen to build the Mishkan. Rashi comments that Chur was the son of Miriam. Miriam was the one who believed from the very beginning that the Jews would be liberated from Egypt and that the men and women should continue having children. This midda of hope started with Miriam, was inherited by Chur, and because they stuck to believing in the seemingly impossible, they were zoche to have their descendant build the mishkan. May we learn from this *middah*, and believe that we can always strive to go above and beyond, even when it seems impossible.
